

## **Mandatory Recycling Program Requirements**

## MANDATORY RECYCLING PROGRAMS:

- Commercial businesses must have recycling services in place to be compliant with the State of California Mandatory Recycling Regulations. Please visit **www.CalRecycle.ca.gov** for more information.
- Milpitas Sanitation has a **dual stream recycling program. THERE IS NO LONGER A SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLABLES PROGRAM.** Customers must have **either** split carts for recycling **or** at least two dedicated recyclable carts (carts for paper and fibers and carts for recyclable plastic, glass, metal containers).
- Based on certain levels of garbage collection services, commercial businesses must have organics recycling services in place to be compliant with the State of California Mandatory Recycling Regulations. Please see the AB1826 chart below or visit **www.CalRecycle.ca.gov** for more information.
- Dedicated Food Scraps Carts are for food scraps and food-soiled paper only. Internal food scraps collection containers are available upon request. Please contact us to have our recycling coordinator visit to audit your recycling program needs. If no food scraps container is present, food scraps will go in the garbage.
- Dedicated Yard Trimmings Carts are for clean yard trimmings only. Food scraps and food-soiled paper belong in the appropriate food scraps collection container. If no food scraps container is present, food scraps will go in the garbage.
