PROPER SORTING MAKES A DIFFERENCE! - Using the right cart or bin to sort your waste means less garbage goes to the landfill!

REDUCE WASTE - To be removed from direct mail registries, register at: **DirectMail.com** or **DMAchoice.org**. To discontinue unwanted catalogs, register at: **CatalogChoice.org**.

REDUCE LITTER - Avoid overloading your Recyclables, Garbage, Food Scraps, and Yard Trimmings carts/bins. Keep lids closed when possible. Bag or box small and light-weight items to keep them from blowing away during collection.

REUSE RATHER THAN DISPOSE - Items you no longer want might be of use to someone else. Consider the following resources:
