



Milpitas residential streets are swept twice a month to keep our neighborhood streets clean and storm drains open.

Thanks for doing your part to keep our streets clean and protect our creeks and bay year round!

- *Street sweeping occurs from 8am - 5pm.*
- *Move your vehicle on your street sweeping days.*

When blocked, sweepers cannot keep storm drains clean of dirt, trash and pollutants that accumulate on our streets.

Manage and Dispose of FOG Properly

Don't pour Fats, Oils and Grease (FOG) down your sink drains or toilets. They will clog your pipes and sewer/septic systems.

- **FOR SMALL AMOUNTS OF FOG**, scrape out or use paper towels to wipe your pans, then place the FOG or soiled paper towels in the Food Scraps side of your gray **GARBAGE/FOOD SCRAPS** split cart.
- **FOR LARGE AMOUNTS OF FOG**, use the curbside cooking oil collection program! Residents may place up to two (2) gallons of used cooking oil (in accepted containers) at the curb for collection each week. Oil containers can be requested from Milpitas Sanitation. **Contact us for more information.**
- **FOR EVEN LARGER AMOUNTS OF FOG**, collect cooled oil in a sealable container (no larger than 15 gallons) and take it to a Santa Clara County Household Hazardous Waste Facility. Limits apply. Please visit www.HHW.org or call (408) 299-7300 for more information.
