**REMEMBER THAT FOOD-SOILED PAPER CAN GO INTO THE FOOD SCRAPS SIDE OF YOUR GARBAGE/FOOD SCRAPS SPLIT CART!** Food-soiled paper napkins, towels, cups, plates, soiled newspaper and brown paper bags belong; along with fresh, frozen, moldy peels, pits, rinds, dairy products, bread, pasta, coffee grounds, tea leaves, meats, bones, and backyard fruit and vegetables.

***Did you know?*** You can use any type of plastic bag, newspaper or kraft paper bag to line your Kitchen Food Scraps Pail or the Food Scraps side of your Garbage/Food Scraps split cart.
