WHAT IS HAZARDOUS WASTE?

Hazardous items like pesticides, fertilizers, pool & photo chemicals, paints, varnishes, thinners, toxic cleaning products, smoke detectors, thermometers, CFLs/fluorescent light bulbs, unwanted medications, sharps (needles, lancets, etc.), automotive fluids, batteries and propane/fuel tanks need to be taken to a hazardous waste collection facility. HOW DOES MY BUSINESS PROPERLY DISPOSE OF HAZARDOUS WASTE?


Businesses may not use the residential hazardous waste program. Some small business owners in Santa Clara County may qualify for the Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator (CESQG) program. AB 1826 Mandatory Organics Recycling

By the numbers. For BUSINESSES and MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENCES WITH 5 OR MORE UNITS:

JANUARY 1, 2016

*This law requires that on and after January 1, 2016, local jurisdictions across the state **implement an organic waste recycling program to divert organic waste** generated by businesses, including multi-family residential dwellings with five or more units.

Your Green Yard Trimmings Cart or Bin

Yard trimmings & clean wood only. Food scraps & food-soiled paper belong in your food scraps cart.

YARD TRIMMINGS

- · flowers & leaves
- ivy & weeds
- grass clippings
- small branches (less than 6" in diameter)
- tree stumps (smaller than 16" in diameter)
- untreated dimensional lumber (less than 24" long)

PLEASE REMEMBER: NØ Glass, Metal, Styrofoam or Plastic, Food Scraps, Liquid Fat,
Oil or Grease, Aseptic Boxes, Pet Litter or Feces, Palm Fronds, Dirt, Rock, Concrete, Brick or Treated Wood



Your Brown Food Scraps Cart or Bin*

All fresh, frozen, cooked & moldy food belongs.

FOOD SCRAPS & FOOD-SOILED PAPER All Fresh, Frozen, Cooked & Moldy Food Scraps Including:

- peels, pits & rinds
- dairy products
- bread & pasta
- coffee grounds & tea leaves
- meats & bones
- · backyard fruits & vegetables

Food-Soiled Paper

- soiled napkins, paper towels & pizza box liners
- soiled newspaper & kraft paper bags

PLEASE REMEMBER: NØ Yard Trimmings or Recyclable Materials, Dirt or Concrete, Paint, Batteries, Fluorescent Bulbs, Poison, or other Hazardous Waste
