RECYCLING & WASTE REDUCTION GUIDELINES FOR MANUFACTURERS

Increase Recycling and Reduce Waste!

MAINTAIN A GREEN MANUFACTURING PROCESS

- Reduce the amont of excess raw materials kept in stock.
- Order only the amount of materials needed for a specific amount of time.
- Manufacture products with minimal packaging, have the highest recycled content and are recyclable.
 (See "Recycling Market Development Zone" on other side)
- Design and use products and processes that minimize the amount of hazardous substances used.



REDUCE PACKAGING MATERIALS

- Design the product packaging to use the minimum amount of materials.
- Use reusable or recyclable packing content.

INCREASE EFFICIENCY REDUCE WASTE

- Establish a preventative maintenance schedule to keep equipment in good working order.
- Make sure your warehouse is organized and well-marked. Track the locations of inventory, tools, supplies and assests.
- Use digital marketing (online catalogs, email newletter, mobile marketing) and a paperless inventory tracking system to reduce paper waste.



MAKE THE MOST OF YOUR COLLECTION PROGRAM

- Work with your landlord and/or neighboring tenants to choose the rightsized containers and maintain clean and efficient collection area(s).
- Make the most of our recyclables and organics programs to reduce disposal costs. (See "Contact Milpitas Sanitation" below for assistance)

Proper Sorting Makes a Difference!

Items going in the **RECYCLABLES** bins, dedicated and/or split carts should be empty and clean.

Items going in the YARD TRIMMINGS and FOOD SCRAPS carts or bins should be free of glass, metal, and plastic (plastic bags allowed in food scraps).



BLUE = RECYCLABLES



GREEN = YARD TRIMMINGS



BROWN = FOOD SCRAPS



GRAY = GARBAGE

Keep the Recycling Stream Clean!

Garbage and Organics <u>DO NOT</u> belong in the blue **RECYCLABLES** bins, dedicated carts and split carts. Make sure recyclable plastic, metal and glass food containers are empty and clean before placing them in the blue **RECYCLABLES** container(s). Non-recyclable materials cause contamination, can damage sorting machinery, and result in recyclables in the landfill.

PLEASE NOTE: FILM PLASTIC/SHRINK WRAP, FOAM BLOCKS AND WOODEN PALLETS DO NOT BELONG IN THE RECYCLABLES!

The Recycling Market Development Zone (RMDZ) Program

The Recycling Market Development Zone (RMDZ) program combines recycling with economic development to fuel new businesses, expand existing ones, create jobs, and divert waste from landfills.

This program provides:

- Attractive loans.
- Technical assistance.
- Free product marketing.
