Straws Upon Request

ASSEMBLY BILL (AB) 1884 BANS FULL-SERVICE RESTAURANTS FROM OFFERING SINGLE-USE PLASTIC STRAWS UNLESS REQUESTED BY THE CUSTOMER. The law took effect January 1, 2019 and aims to reduce plastic pollution and single-use plastic.



REDUCE PLASTIC POLLUTION BY FOLLOWING THESE TIPS:

- ☑ **JUST SAY "NO" TO SINGLE-USE ITEMS** Refuse the straw at restaurants and/or bring your own. Avoid items that are packaged in "individual" or "single-use" sizes.
- ☑ USE REUSABLES INSTEAD OF SINGLE-USE ITEMS Bring your reusable totes and bags on shopping trips. Carry a reusable water bottle with you. Bring your travel mug to the coffee shop.
- ☑ **KEEP THE STREAM CLEAN!** Keep recyclables from going to the landfill by emptying/cleaning them and by properly sorting your waste. More info at: **www.milpitassanitation.com/wishcycling/**.
