- Street sweeping occurs from 8am - 5pm.
- Move your vehicle on your street sweeping days. When blocked, sweepers cannot keep storm drains clean of dirt, trash and pollutants that accumulate on our streets.

Residential Service Reminders

PROPER SORTING MAKES A DIFFERENCE! Make sure you sort your waste correctly. Need more space? Additional Yard Trimmings Carts and Recyclables Split Carts can be provided at no cost.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF USED MOTOR OIL, COOKING OIL AND MOTOR OIL FILTERS.

Contain used oil in sealed 1-gallon, screw-top containers and filters in a sealed zipper-lock style bag. Please do not mix motor oil and cooking oil. Place containers/bags on the curb (not in the gutter) next to (not inside) your Blue Recyclables Split Cart for collection. No other automotive liquids accepted. Containers/bags are available at fire stations and from Milpitas Sanitation. 2 gallons/1 bag collection limit per resident per week.



HOUSEHOLD BATTERY COLLECTION. Place household batteries in a clear plastic zipper-lock style bag. Tape terminals on lithium and 9-volt batteries. (No car batteries allowed.) Place on top of (not inside) your Blue Recyclables Split Cart for collection.
