

## **Senate Bill 1383 Compliance Waivers for Commercial Businesses**

(including Multi-Family Dwellings)

## What is Senate Bill 1383?

In 2016, <u>Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383)</u> was signed by Governor Brown to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from a variety of short-lived climate pollutants, including methane from organic waste. Organics like food scraps, yard trimmings, paper, and cardboard make up approximately half of what Californian's dump in landfills. Organic waste decomposing in landfills is a large source of methane emissions, a climate super pollutant much more potent than carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>). Senate Bill 1383 is a state law that requires organic material be diverted away from landfills and surplus food be made available to food-insecure communities.

All businesses and multi-family properties will need to have organic waste collection services (yard trimmings and food scraps). Milpitas Sanitation, Inc., is available to assist businesses to sign up for collection services ((408) 988-4500 or <a href="www.milpitassanitation.com">www.milpitassanitation.com</a>) and/or provide technical assistance and training.

## Is Your Business Eligible for a Waiver from SB 1383 Compliance?

Your business may be eligible for a waiver if little to no paper waste, food waste, or green waste is generated on-site. To apply, complete each section of the application form and submit to <a href="MilpitasRecycles@milpitas.gov">MilpitasRecycles@milpitas.gov</a> (or City Hall- Solid Waste Team, 455 E Calaveras Blvd, Milpitas, CA, 95035).

The City will conduct unscheduled site visits before and after the application process to ensure that your business meets the waiver requirements. If the requirements are not met, or are not consistent with the application, the City will rescind the waiver and you will be out of compliance for SB 1383.

Please see the chart below to determine whether you may be eligible for an SB 1383 waiver.
