# Fall & Winter Leaf Clean-up

Place leaves and branches in your green YARD TRIMMINGS cart every week to keep these materials out of storm drains and the street.

DID YOU KNOW? Street sweepers are designed to pick up smaller debris, not large piles of leaves. If the vehicle comes into contact with a pile of leaves, it will spread the leaves all over the street. During the Fall/Winter, targeted neighborhood streets are swept for excess leaves once a week during the months of November and December.

# **Manage & Dispose of FOG Properly**

Improper disposal of Fats, Oils, & Grease (FOG) will pollute the environment & clog your pipes & sewer/septic systems.

SMALL amounts of FOG - Place in the Food Scraps side of your gray GARBAGE/FOOD SCRAPS split cart.

LARGE amounts of FOG - Use the curbside cooking oil collection program! Residents may place up to two (2) gallons of used cooking oil (in accepted containers) at the curb for collection each week. Oil containers can be requested from Milpitas Sanitation. Contact us for more information.

LARGER amounts of FOG - Collect cooled oil in a sealable container (no larger than 15 gallons) and take it to a Santa Clara County Household Hazardous Waste Facility. Limits apply. Please visit www.HHW.org or call (408) 299-7300 for more information.

There are NO CHANGES to the residential service schedule during the New Year's Day Holiday week.


# Sustainable Holiday Tree Ideas

"BEST BY"

Indicates when a product

will be of best flavor or qual-

ity. Not a purchase/safety/

expiration date.

# "SELL BY"

Tells the store how long to display the product for sale for inventory management. Not a safety/expiration date.



# "USE BY"

Last date recommended for use of the product while at peak quality. Not a safety/ expiration date except when used on infant formula.
