**The Recycling Market Development Zone (RMDZ) Program** 

The Recycling Market Development Zone (RMDZ) program combines recycling with economic development to fuel new businesses, expand existing ones, create jobs, and divert waste from landfills.

This program provides:

- Attractive loans.
- Technical assistance.
- Free product marketing.

Qualifying businesses must manufacture their products with recycled content material(s) and be located in a zone. Local incentives vary from jurisdiction to jurisdiction. For more information on the program, zone locations, and how to qualify, scan the code to the right.

This does not apply to:

- Correctional institutions
- Licensed health care facilities
- Residential care facilities
- Public and private school cafeterias
