

MILPITAS RESIDENTIAL STREETS ARE SWEPT TWICE A MONTH TO KEEP OUR NEIGHBORHOOD STREETS CLEAN AND STORM DRAINS OPEN

Please remember to move your vehicle on your street sweeping days. Vehicles left on the street block the sweepers and prevent them from keeping our storm drains clean, which in turn pollutes our bay as storm drains flow directly to the bay.



When vehicles and other obstructions block the street, sweepers cannot remove debris against the curb.

A Word About Cardboard

Milpitas is doing a great job of keeping most recyclable items out of the landfill through proper sorting, although some recyclable items are still frequently found in the garbage. One of the most common recyclable items found in the garbage is cardboard. All clean cardboard can be recycled by placing it in the correct container. For properties with:



- Split cart service flatten cardboard, cut large pieces down to 2'x 2', then place in the yellow lid side of the blue recyclables split cart. Have extra cardboard? Flatten, cut, and stack next to cart. DO NOT place in other streams.
- Dedicated cart service flatten cardboard, cut large pieces down to 2'x 2', then place in the blue paper/fiber cart with the yellow lid. Have extra cardboard? Flatten, cut, and stack next to cart. DO NOT place in other streams.
- · Bin service flatten cardboard then place in the blue paper/fiber bin.
