

PLEASE REMEMBER TO MOVE YOUR VEHICLE OR OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS ON YOUR STREET SWEEPING DAYS

Milpitas residential streets are swept twice a month to keep our neighborhood streets clean and storm drains open.



When vehicles and other obstructions block the street, sweepers cannot remove the litter against the curb.

- *Street sweeping occurs from 8am - 5pm.*

Milpitas Residents Can Recycle Batteries, Cooking Oil, Motor Oil, and Oil Filters Curbside

CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF USED MOTOR OIL, COOKING OIL, AND MOTOR OIL FILTERS

Contain used oil in 1-gallon, screw-top jugs and oil filters in a sealed zipper-lock style bag. **Please do not mix motor oil and cooking oil.** Place jugs/bags on the curb (not in the gutter) next to (not inside) your Blue Recyclables Split Cart for collection. No other automotive fluids accepted. Jugs/bags are available at fire stations and from Milpitas Sanitation. 2 gallons/1 bag collection limit per home per week.



HOUSEHOLD BATTERY COLLECTION Place household batteries in a clear plastic zipper-lock style bag. Tape terminals on lithium and 9-volt batteries. (No car batteries allowed.) Place sealed bag on top of (not inside) your Blue Recyclables Split Cart for collection.
